As a citizen, you have a right, and some say an obligation, to vote in local, state, and national elections. The Capital District Association of Rental Property Owners has observed that too many tenants do not exercise this right. In response to this fact, CDARPO has launched the first of several quality of life initiatives entitled "Tenants Count."

Many renters mistakenly believe that they do not have a stake or interest in the process. This is absolutely untrue. If your elected officials raise taxes, water and sewer rates, or increase other fees borne by the landlord, those elevated expenses increase the rent that must be charged to you and your family. Conversely, if governmental programs contribute to cost savings, everyone benefits.

The objectives of CDARPO are threefold:

1. Encourage the thousands of potential voters within our zone of influence to register to vote.
2. Keep our tenants and others informed regarding current and pending legislation of interest.
3. Prompt new and already established registered voters to vote in large numbers.

If you feel that public safety, clean streets, the local library or other services are important to you, then you should vote for those who support and enhance the living experience for you and your family.

Attached is a New York State Voter Registration form. It is necessary to be registered in order to vote in any election. You may either mail or deliver in person the registration form to the county Board of Elections noted on each sheet.
